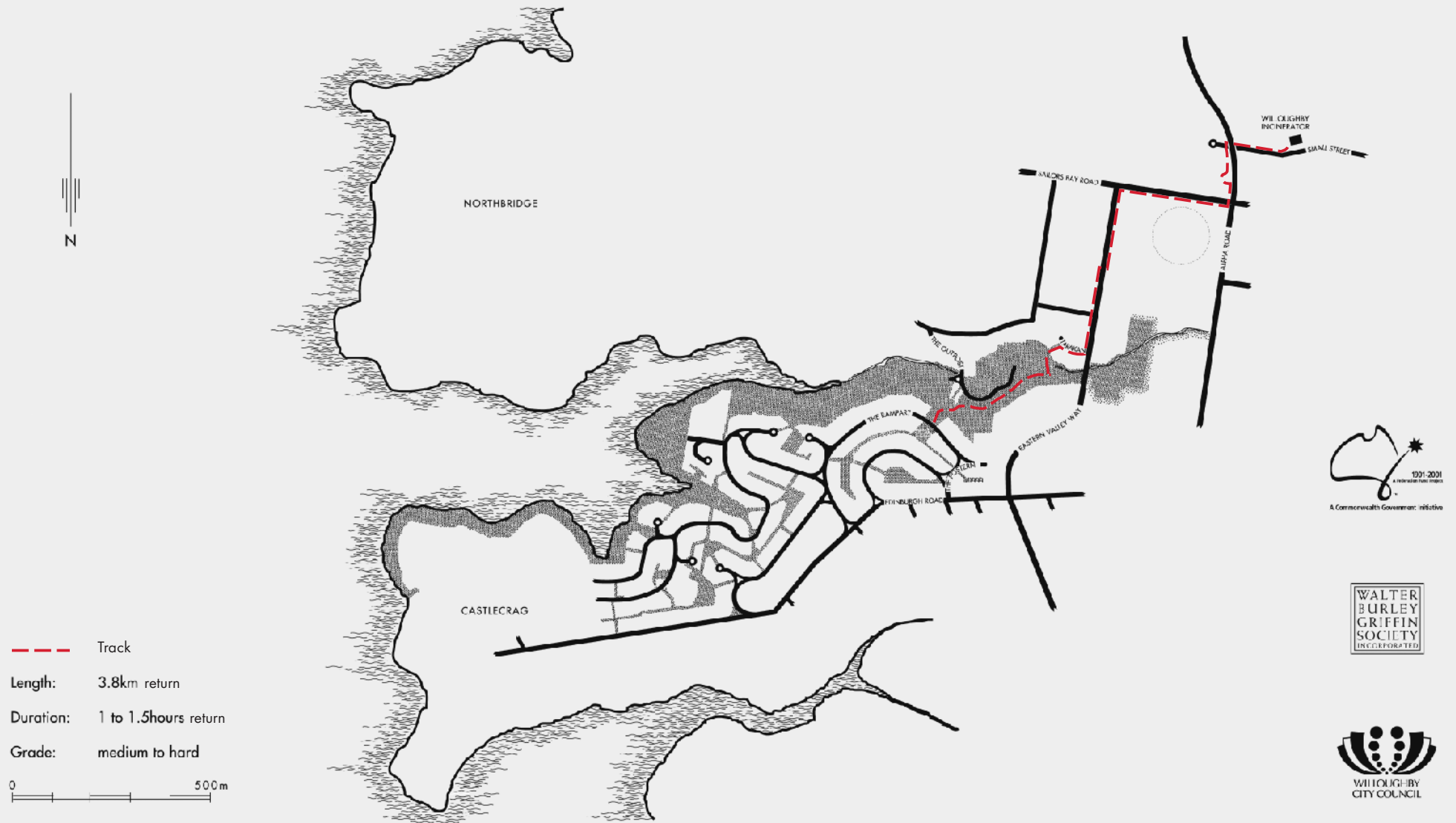


GRIFFIN FEDERATION TRACK



This walking track links the Conservation Area of Castlecrag with Northbridge and also the Willoughby Incinerator, a building designed by Walter Burley Griffin in 1933, located in what is now Bicentennial Reserve.

The Griffin Conservation Area in Castlecrag, planned as a model suburb, is a reminder of the vision of Marion Mahony and Walter Burley Griffin to create a community living in harmony with the natural environment on the shores of Middle Harbour.

Construction of this track was made possible by a Commonwealth Government Federation Fund grant to the Walter Burley Griffin Society Inc., and with the assistance of the Willoughby City Council.
